Report to Parish Council – January 2021

Café remained closed to end of December 2020, despite lifting of restrictions by Government. No other bookings taken.

21st November craft fayre went ahead via online. Ros and Julie developed a method and spent long hours monitoring to ensure no non-participating stallholders took part. Raffle numbers sold to raise funds. The event appears to have been popular with stall holders and villagers alike.

Two residents have funded a local gardener to help maintain the flower beds.

The monthly Lottery continues. 2 prizes. Plenty of numbers still available. It is open to parishioners, people with a connection to the village and village hall (café customers). Need to sell more numbers to raise funds for the hall. Currently breaks even.

Regular contribution for the Cockcrow written and submitted by Ros.

Rob (Treasurer) successfully applied for further grant funding from SNDC to assist with funds during Covid pandemic.

Maintenance items continue including boiler service due in February. Purchase of heating oil, window cleaning and interior cleaning, water and electricity charges.
